PARTECIPATION

Open to all athletes with the license of the Italian Cycling Federation – F.C.I. recognized U.C.I. and to all members of a non-Italian National Cycling Federation with respective license. For riders without a license, a one-day F.C.I. license will be issued for a fee of Euro 15.00 which provides liability insurance during the event. This license will be issued only upon presentation of a valid medical certificate of fitness for competitive sports. (F.C.I. law nr. 165 dated December 6th, 2007 – off-road department).

MARATHON (103.9 km): OPEN Men/Women (Élite – Under 23), ÉLITE SPORT, MASTER MEN (M1- M2 – 3 – 4 - 5 and Over), MASTER WOMEN (Élite Sport Women – Master Women)

GRANFONDO (51.6 km): UNDER 23 Men/Women, ELITE Men/Women, JUNIORES, MASTER: all categories Amateur (Men and Women)

TILIMENT JUNIOR (19.5 km/16.5hm): Youths Men/Women 1st and 2nd year, Student Men/Women 1st and 2nd year

ITALIAN PARALYMPIC CHAMPIONSHIP (16.5 km): still to be confirmed

ECOLOGICAL BIKE RIDE (16.5 km): no-competitive race open to all (registration ONLY on Saturday morning)

The registration form is available in our website and must be entirely completed (also indicating UCI code) and accompanied by receipt of the bank transfer. Direct link: Subscribe online https://www.mysdam.net/i_34626 Participants' phone number and/or E-mail address are necessary to the organizer to confirm the registration of the participant or group. The registration fee is: **Euro 50,00** for Marathon race (km 103.9) and **Euro 35** for Granfondo race (km 51.6) by **31.03.2017 at midnight**; From 1st April 2017 Euro 55 for Marathon race (km 103.9) and Euro 40 for Granfondo race (km 51.6). Registrations must be sent to the organization until **Thursday 20th APRIL 2017 at midnight**.

THIS YEAR DUE TO ORGANISATIONAL REASONS, IT WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE TO REGISTER AFTER THIS DATE, OR ON SITE DURING THE DAYS BEFORE THE EVENT! PAY ATTENTION! NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE!

Incomplete registrations, without indication of the UCI code or missing receipt of bank transfer will be deemed as invalid.

FCI MEMBERS, EVEN IF THEY ARE REGISTERED THROUGH COMPULSORY "FACTOR K" SYSTEM, ARE OBLIGED TO MAKE THE REGISTRATION AS DESCRIBED BEFORE.

The registration fee for the ecological bike ride is **Euro 10,00** (only Saturday, 22nd April 2017 from 10 a.m. until 30 minutes before race start).

DAILY ITALIAN CYCLING FEDERATION – F.C.I. LICENSE

Those who are not in possession of a F.C.I. (Italian Cycling Federation) license can apply for a daily membership license by the registration by ticking "Richiedo tessera FCI" whether competitive or non-competitive on the registration form; the cost for the daily license is € 15,00 and goes entirely to FCI. For the issue of a competitive daily license, a medical certificate of fitness for the cycling activity in the original copy is required. For the issue of a non-competitive daily license or for the participation as non-members, it is necessary to present a medical certificate of good health.

For touring-cyclists a daily license is not mandatory but may be required at one's own discretion. Touring-cyclists both with or without license, can participate exclusively to the non-competitive ride. For the release of the competitive daily license and for the participation of foreign licensed members, it is necessary to subscribe the ethical declaration provided by the rules of the F.C.I. and deliver it to the organization (except hikers).

Once registered as above described, the participant is asked to notify the organization at the e-mail address info@tilimentmarathonbike.it or through the Official Facebook Page of the event, its registration through daily license. On race day, the athlete will have to be identified during the withdrawal of the race pack and the organization (already informed!) will end the registration.

In conclusion:

Participation is open to all F.C.I. licensed athletes recognized by U.C.I. and to all foreign athletes who are licensed with their respective National Federations. Alternatively only presenting a valid competitive medical certificate at registration, with an additional cost of € 15,00 for the daily F.C.I. insurance licence (F.C.I. law 165 of 06/12/2007 - Off-road sector).

RACE NUMBER & PACKET PICK-UP AND LICENSE CHECK

The check of license and/or new registration, race packet and number pick-up will be open on Saturday, 22nd April 2017 at 12 noon until 8 p.m. and Sunday, 23rd April 2017 from 7 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. c/o Piazza Walterpertoldo n. 4 in Spilimbergo. Race Packet includes: local gastronomic products, supplements, Pasta-Party ticket, discount voucher by Technical Sponsor...

The new registration and/or the packet pick-up can be collected by the participant or other persons. In case of other persons, they must be in possession of all licenses.

STARTING GRIDS

They will be structured as follows:

- Block 1) Ranking UCI, Guests, Open Men/Women, Master Women
- Block 2) Grid reserved for Friuli Challenge riders
- Block 3) Master

All bikers, before having access to the starting grids, must transit in fixed points created by the organization for the race number check.

IF A BIKER DOES NOT ENTER IN THE FIXED POINTS FOR THE RACE NUMBER CHECK, THE GRID WILL BE INVALIDATED AND HE WILL NOT BE RANKED IN THE FINAL CLASSIFICATION.

TIMING

The timing will be carried out by an Official Timer MySDAM based on the use of a chip technology. Every participant will have to be provided of a valid **personal chip** or a rental **daily chip**. Info and conditions about the use of chips are published on MySDAM web-site at www.mysdam.net/info-chip.do.

VALID CHIPS:

- **Personal My SDAM A-CHIP** (round and green) with qualification "Cycling and MTB 2017".
- **Personal CHAMPIONCHIP YELLOW** (round and yellow)
- **DAILY MySDAM CHIP** on hire

PLEASE NOTE

- Indicate the personal chip code on the registration form.
- The chips and / or the related certifications can be purchased on www.mysdam.net site or at the chip point "Punto Chip" of the race.
- The daily chip can be rented only at the chip point of the race at a cost of € 5.00 by paying a deposit of € 10,00. The deposit, less the cost of rental, will be refunded at return of the chip that must be made at the chip point within 15 minutes from the end of the race.
- Updated prices and conditions relating to the chips are listed on MySDAM site: www.mysdam.it/info-chip.do
- The BlueChip and other chip types not specifically mentioned can not be used.
- Failure or incorrect use of the chip will cause the non-inclusion in the classification and the non-attribution of the time taken.

FINAL CLASSIFICATION

The classification of the race XCM C3, valid as trail of U.C.I. MTB World Series, includes only riders in possession of an annual licence (2017) for the cycling competitive- or amateur- activity, released by the Italian Cycling Federation – F.C.I. or by a non-Italian National Cycling Federation adhering to the U.C.I., who completed the Marathon race; the classification will be prepared and delivered according to U.C.I. and F.C.I. rules. The Classification of the Marathon route (Overall) includes all bikers with annual license who regularly finished the chosen route.

MEDICAL SUPPORT

Medical support includes ambulances, off-road vehicles, doctors, health support staff, availability of helicopter rescue service and a station of the Italian Red Cross (Croce Rossa Italiana) located in the center of Spilimbergo.

VEHICLE MECHANICAL ASSISTANCE

Any support by non-official vehicles during the course of the race is strictly forbidden and will cause the disqualification, except for the places on the route indicated by the Organization Committee.

APPEALS

Any appeal or protest regarding the race should be addressed to the jury in the terms pretended by the F.C.I. (Federazione Ciclistica Italiana), the Italian Cycling Federation and the U.C.I. (Union Cycliste Internationale) regulations and should be accompanied by the fee, when requested.

EVENT CANCELLATION

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to make changes to the regulations and to the course of the race. The event will take place irrespective of weather conditions provided that there is no risk to the health or safety of the participants. The Organizing Committee retains the right to interrupt or cancel the race at any moment if necessary. Should the race be cancelled for circumstances beyond the control of the Organizers, the entry fee will not be refunded nor used for the following years.

RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

1. The number and the chip, provided by the Organization, have to be fixed to the handlebars in a clearly visible manner.
2. The number cannot be modified or changed in any way.
3. Bikers must wear a hard safety approved helmet which must be kept fastened throughout the race.
4. Road safety regulations must be respected on crossroads and paved roads .
5. Participants stopped at the gates of maximal time limit are required to deliver their race number and chip to the person appointed for such purpose.
6. Any biker not arriving at the starting grid 15 minutes prior to its fixed start will automatically be allocated to the final starting grid.
7. Overtaking the starting grid causes a penalty and the consequent allocation to the final starting grid.
8. Bikers are required to move aside to allow faster bikers to overtake.
9. Extreme prudence is to be exercised in the parts of the course with poor visibility.
10. Any stop for repairs must be made in a clearly visible area away from the main race course.
11. Participants who quit the race have to inform the Organization and hand back race number and chip to the next security controller along the route.
12. This year the use of video cameras or similar means to record the race (on the helmet, on the bikes or worn by the participant) is for safety reasons strictly forbidden.
13. Any violation of this stipulation will lead to the biker being disqualified.

DISQUALIFICATION

Any biker found to be taking part with the race number of another, to have passed one's race number to another, or guilty of other serious offence determined by the Organization Committee, will be immediately excluded from the event and any position in race classification will be cancelled, and the biker may be subject to a ban from participating in future editions of between two and five years.

Since the race takes place in a protected natural area, it is **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN** to use any motorized vehicle on the entire route except for free access ways.

The beginning and the end of refreshment points are very well indicated by special signs, bikers are reminded of their duty not to throw litter on the race route and to make use of the rubbish points.

Bikers throwing litter on the ground and not making use of the services provided will be disqualified.

RESPONSIBILITY

The Amateur Sports Association Polisportiva Trivium and its organizers, decline any responsibility for itself and for its staff, for any accident or damage to people or things, that could occur before, during or after the event or as a consequence or the same. All participants in the Tiliment Marathon Bike participate at their own risk. The enrolment, even if done by a third party on one's behalf, infers and provides that the participant accepts to waive any right, direct, or of third parties, against the Organizing Committee and all individuals or organizations involved in the event. Furthermore, by enrolling in the event the participant declares to be sufficiently in form to face the challenge required to complete the race.

REGULATIONS

Matters not covered by this regulation shall be subject to the implementing rules 2017 of the F.C.I. (Federazione Ciclistica Italiana), the Italian Cycling Federation and UCI (Union Cycliste Internationale).

PRIVACY

Personal data of the participants are used exclusively by the organization with respect of privacy laws and preserved only for the event's purposes. The organizers will not divulgate the personal data to a third party.

The Organizing Society declines any responsibility with regard to multimedia materials such as photos and videos taken during the race and published by third parties. The organization informs that along the route there will be official photographers with uniform and distinctive pass. With the registration, participants give their consent to the use of personal data and "official" images for the event's purposes or advertising (law on privacy: n. 675 of 31/12/1996).

GENERAL RULES FOR PARTICIPANTS

By participating, riders confirm that:

- a) They renounce to any complaint right, towards third parties, the Organizing Committee and all natural and legal persons involved in the event
- b) they meet the requirements imposed by this regulation and by the law in force
- c) they understand the nature of the event and are in proper physical condition to participate without causing risks to himself or to other participants
